Protection of Personal Information

In order to provide radiology services to our patients, certain private personal identifying information may be collected. That information may be kept by DRA in paper document and electronic form.

DRA recognizes a responsibility to protect the confidentiality of our patients' personal information and has instituted a number of safeguards to limit access to the information and to minimize the chances of unintended disclosure. The safeguards include:

1. Compliance with patient privacy requirements of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA).
2. Maintenance of an inventory of the locations of stored information.
3. Protections to limit physical access to DRA premises and the locations of stored information.
4. Protections to limit electronic access to stored information.
5. Monitoring of the safeguards.
6. Destruction of documents or electronic information before disposal.
